

Combat Veterans Motorcycle Association® Auxiliary Huachuca Mountain Chapter, AZ 32-4 High School Student Scholarship

(3) \$750 scholarships available

Eligibility

- Must be a dependent child of a Veteran (Active Duty, Reserve, National Guard or Retired) member of the United States Military.
- Must be a Cochise County graduating high school senior who has planned to enroll in a full time (at least 12 semester hours) undergraduate course of study at an accredited two- or four-year college, university, or trade school for the entire upcoming academic year.
- Must have a minimum cumulative 2.5 grade point average on a 4.0 scale, or the equivalent, at the time of application, from a Cochise County high school.

Awards

One \$750 scholarship will be awarded to three graduating high school students. Scholarships are awarded on a one-time basis to first time recipients only. The funds are unrestricted and may be used to pay tuition, fees, or books. Funds will only be provided to the school attending.

Application

Eligible students must submit a scholarship application, proof of parent/guardian's military service, at least one letter of recommendation, proof of enrollment in a two- or four-year college, university, or trade school, Cochise County high school transcripts, brief resume, and an original 500-word essay to the CVMA® Auxiliary, Chapter 32-4 received no later than **15 April 2024**. Report cards are not acceptable as transcripts. Acceptable proof of parent/guardian's military service includes: copy of the parent/guardian's Form DD214, Statement of Service, or other proof of service to verify eligibility. Social Security numbers and DOB should be removed/blacked out of submitted copy. Incomplete or illegible applications will not be accepted. Applicants are responsible for gathering and submitting all necessary information in one packet. Encrypted emails cannot be opened.

Selection Process

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of academic record, demonstrated leadership/ participation in school/community activities, honors, work experience, statement of goals/aspirations, recommendation, and content/quality of essay. The essay scoring rubric is available upon request. Recipients will be selected from a pool of qualified applicants. Not all applicants will be selected. Scholarship applications will be reviewed on/around 22 April 2024 and notification will be made by email on/around 1 May 2024. **The scholarship must be used within the 2024/25 school year.**

Items required for consideration: (incomplete packets will not be evaluated)

- This application form
- Proof of parent/guardian's military service (SSN & DOB blacked out)
- Letter of recommendation (Teacher, Counselor, JROTC Instructor, Religious leader, employer, etc.).
- Proof of acceptance or enrollment with college, university, or trade school. The scholarship funds will only be released to the school, not to the applicant.
- **CURRENT** Cochise County high school unofficial transcripts with GPA
- Resume (i.e. school, community, or social activities; academic honors/awards; volunteer service; sports; employment, etc.)
- Essay: **500-word minimum, 750-word maximum.** Essays will be graded on content including grammar, spelling, punctuation, composition, and the ability to stay on topic. Rubric available upon request. Choose one of the two topics below:
 - **Topic 1:** *Choose three of the following character traits and explain what they mean to you and how you exemplify the concepts. Loyalty; Patriotism; Honor; Respect; and Selfless Service.*
 - **Topic 2:** *How has your parent's military service set you apart from non-military students?*
